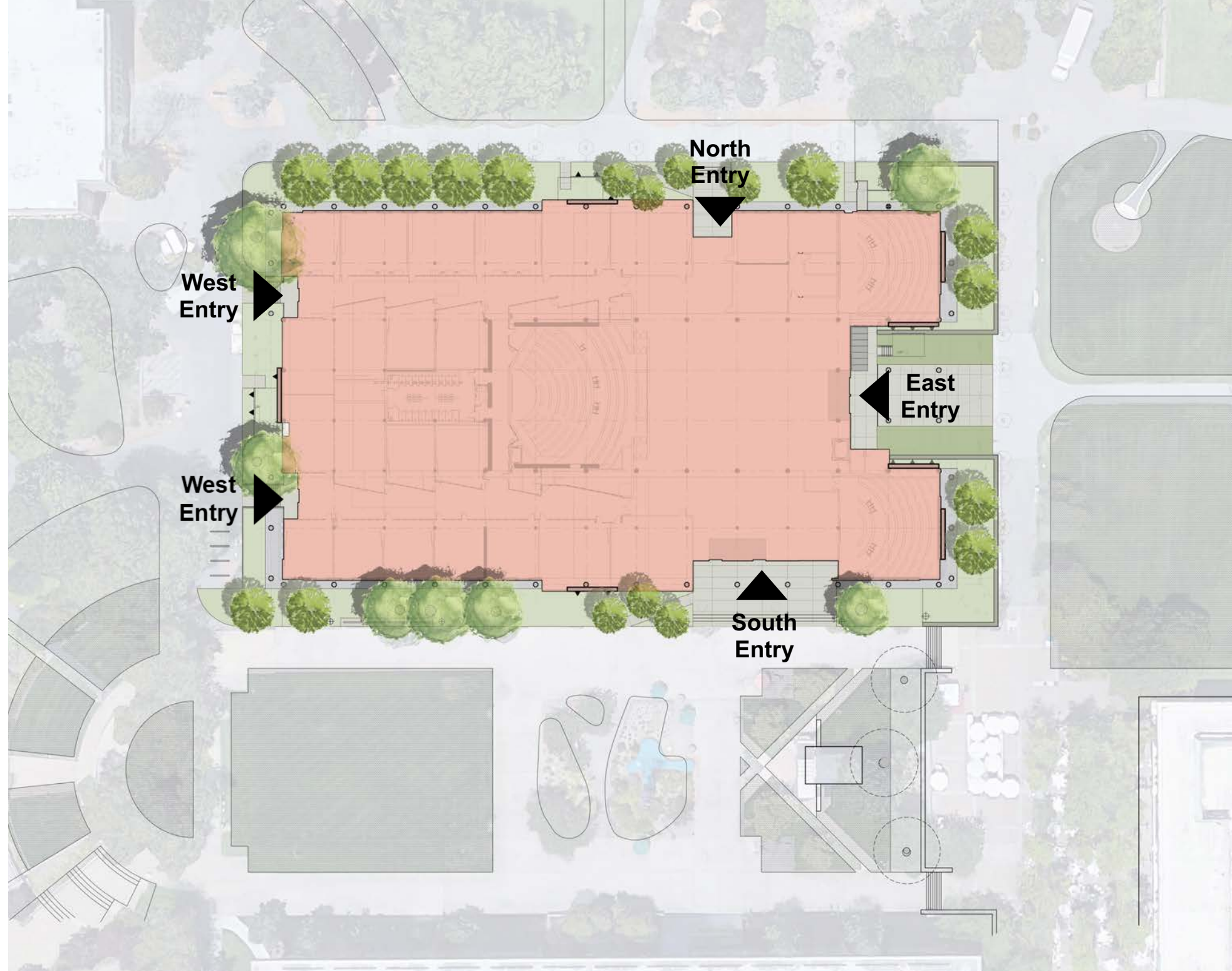


The overall Vision of the Stevenson Hall Renovation Project is to create a space:

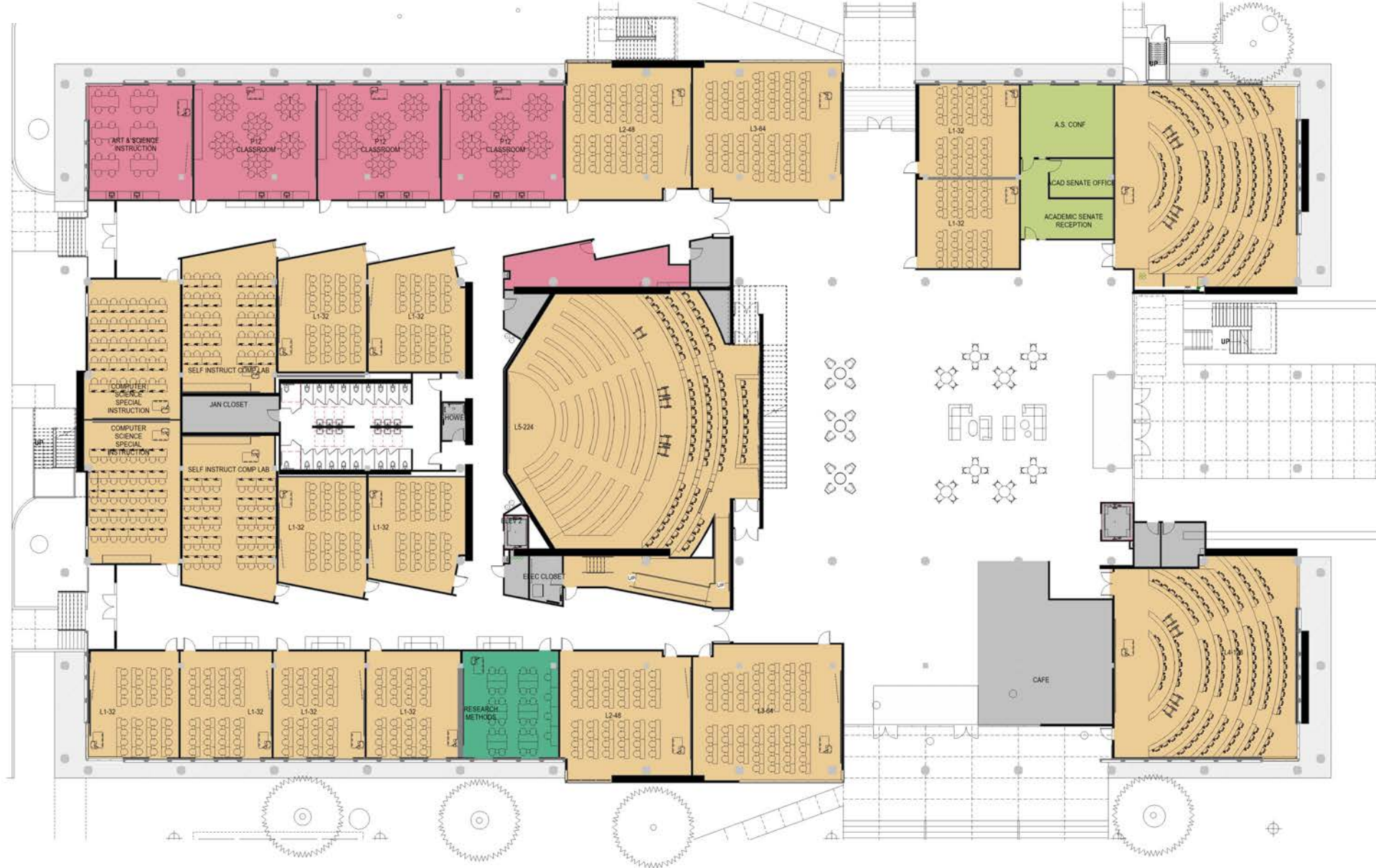
- That is Welcoming, Accessible and supports a strong sense of **Community**;
